Laboratory Tests

Advances in anesthesia and surgery have made routine procedures relatively safe with a low rate of complications. Nevertheless, occasional problems can arise due to pre-existing conditions. **To avoid these problems, a blood profile is required on all pets over the age of seven (7) years. Our doctors recommend it for all animals going into surgery, regardless of age.** These tests are similar to ones your physician would run if you were undergoing anesthesia. The results may also serve as reference values for future use.

Additional Services Performed While Under Anesthesia

A Home Again microchip is a form of life long ID implanted under the skin. Your pet will be registered with the American Kennel Club. Most hospitals and shelters have scanners. If your pet becomes lost this will increase the chance for a safe return.
